Important Reminder: The school's aim is to provide as many extra-curricular clubs as possible. A barrier to this is that in order for a club to be viable to run the company providing it needs to have a minimum number of children taking part each week. Due to the size of our year groups and the school's relatively remote location (i.e. incurred transportation costs to the provider) there is a limit to those willing to work with us. I will be in frequent and on going negotiations with providers in order to continue to maximise the provision. If, in the meantime, you or someone you knows has a particular skill set that may make a good club for the children either before or after school please do not hesitate to contact me.
