We will be showing the film Home. The film is played in the school hall and costs £2.50 per child, which includes a drink and snack at the beginning and biscuits half way through. We will be delighted to see all the children dressed up (most children do dress up, but please don't worry if your child doesn't want to). There will be a prize for the best costume in each year group. We would ask that your child doesn't wear a full face mask, we have found that some of the younger children have been scared of the masks in previous years. Like Film Club, we ask that Year R children are accompanied by an adult. A hot dog (with sausages from our local butcher), hand decorated cake and drinks throughout the disco are provided. Tickets are on sale from the school office each morning from Thursday 15th October.

Tickets are £3.50 each. This includes the cost of hiring the disco, decorations, hot dog, cake, drinks and prizes. The price has increased from last year but we feel it represents great value for money for a fun and memorable event with good quality food and prizes.

We also have a pumpkin competition, 50p to enter and a prize will be given to the most creative pumpkin design. The pumpkins will be displayed in the hall during the disco, they are lit with battery operated tea lights and look amazing! At the end of the disco we move them outside so all the parents can enjoy them too. Please can you take your pumpkin home at the end of the evening - but leave us the tea lights!
