Smoking in Vehicles

It is illegal to smoke in a car (or other vehicle) with anyone under 18. The law changed on 1 October 2015, to protect children and young people from the dangers of second-hand smoke.

Every time a child breathes in second-hand smoke, they breathe in thousands of chemicals. This puts them at risk of serious conditions including meningitis, cancer, bronchitis and pneumonia. It can also make asthma worse.



Burley Colts Cricket Team

This summer, Burley will be a centre for the ECB's All Stars Cricket scheme aimed at children aged 5-8 years of age.

Sessions will run from 17:30 to 18:30 every Tuesday from May 16 to July 4 inclusive.

The U15s will play in Division Three of the East Dorset League and has entered a side in the new West Hampshire Development League. Training will be 18:30 to 19:30 every Wednesday on the Green from the start of May and most matches will be on a Tuesday.
